Class Updates

Nursery – In Nursery, we are thinking about Houses and Homes. We will be talking about what rooms there are in our houses, what we do in them and who lives with us. We're also working hard to make some beautiful pieces of art for you to enjoy at the MacMillan coffee morning on Friday!

Reception – This week the Spark is 'Vehicles'. We will be exploring what lots of different vehicles do and compare the similarities and differences of them. The children will have opportunities to draw and label their favourite vehicles. In Maths this week we are comparing numbers. We will look at 2 numbers and find out which one is bigger by showing the numbers in objects, using Numicon and building towers.

Year 1 – This week in Year 1, we will be starting a new text in Literacy called 'Princess Smartypants'. We will also be developing our artistic skills by re-creating a piece of art by Pablo Picasso. These will be on display for you to see at the Macmillan Coffee afternoon on Friday.

Year 2 – In Year 2 we are continuing with our story 'Princess Smartypants'. We will be writing a sequel to the story about when Smartypants becomes Queen. In Maths we are beginning to investigate addition and will be using a new word, commutative! We will prove that addition can be calculated both ways round but subtraction cannot. It's the first Reading Cafe of the year after school tomorrow. We hope you can join us and are looking forward to sharing our class books with you.

Year 3 – In Year 3, we are learning about statements in Literacy, to help us describe the BFG. In Maths, we are solving problems using our place value skills and in Science, we are planting cress seeds and hoping they grow using different soils from different locations.

Year 4 – In Year 4, the children are learning about expanded noun phrases in preparation for writing a 'missing person poster'. In Maths, we are using concrete resources to further embed our knowledge of place value. On Wednesday, Year 3 and 4's will have their topic Launch Day, where we will be having a Continental Breakfast for European day of languages. We are all very excited about this.

Year 5 – In Year 5 this week, we will be writing and editing our air-raid diary entries before beginning our World War Two recipes. We will also be continuing with our place value theme, where we will be working with negative numbers. In Science, we will be investigating fossils and our topic learning will take us to Germany this week.

Year 6 – This week, we are recreating art by the European artist, Bob Barker, to display at Friday's MacMillan Coffee afternoon. We will also be using our understanding of wartime rations to create some treats for everyone to enjoy at our Key Stage 2 reading cafe this Thursday! In preparation for our author visit next week, we will be writing and rehearsing interview questions, ready to film during his visit. Watch out for his interview, hosted by the Year 6 children on our school's Facebook page after the 5th October! In Maths, we are continuing to develop our place value understanding by investigating negative numbers and factors. We will be planning and drafting our diary entries this week too, describing life during the war through a child's eyes.
