



<p><u>Tourist Information</u> Research a North American city and create an information text to advertise the city for tourists. You may like to include: a map to show where the city is located; population; famous landmarks and any other interesting facts.</p>  <p>10 Points</p>	<p><u>Famous Landmark</u> Design and make a famous landmark you would like to see in Ripon. Get creative! Think of a landmark that people from all around the world would travel to Ripon to visit. Why is it special to Ripon? Research famous landmarks from around the world for inspiration.</p>  <p>15 Points</p>	<p><u>Animal Adaptation</u> Find out the names of some animals found only in North America and explain why they would not be able to survive in the UK. <i>Can you compare these animals to animals native to the UK? What's the same? What's different?</i></p>  <p>10 points</p>	<p><u>Populations</u> Find out the population of Ripon in North Yorkshire, UK and Ripon in California, North America. Calculate the difference showing your working out. Compare population differences between other North America and UK cities. <i>Can you discover more interesting population comparisons between places in North America and the UK?</i></p>  <p>5 Points</p>	<p><u>County V State</u> On one side of A4 paper, create a piece of art (this could be anything: picture collage, sketching, painting etc) to show a comparison between the county of North Yorkshire and the state of New York.</p>   <p>5 Points</p>
<p><u>Food, glorious food!</u> Find out the journey that some of the food you eat takes to get to your plate. Lots of food comes from different countries. Can you find out which of the foods you eat travel the furthest to get to your plate? Which travels the shortest distance?</p>  <p>10 Points</p>	<p><u>Journey Journal</u> Write a diary entry of a journey you have been on; it could be a walk to town, a trip abroad, a bus journey... any journey you have been on. Describe the journey using your senses: what did you see, hear, feel, smell, touch?</p>  <p>10 Points</p>	<p><u>Positivity Poster</u> Create a poster to display in the classroom with top tips for how to stay positive when life gets tricky.</p>  <p>15 Points</p>	<p><u>Music Maestro</u> Write a song or rap to help you and others in your class to memorise the continents and oceans of the world. Practise it ready to teach to the class.</p>  <p>10 Points</p>	<p><u>Internet safety</u> Ask as many people as you can (children and adults) how they stay safe on line. Decide how to collect and present this data clearly to share with others during a computing lessons.</p>  <p>10 Points</p>
