

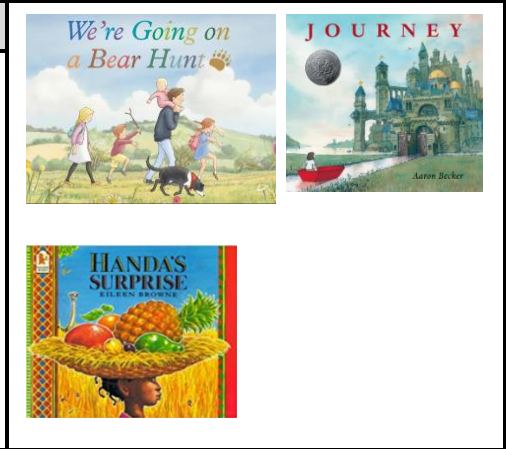

<b>senses</b>	Taste, smell, sight, touch, hearing
<b>shelter</b>	A place to give protection from weather or danger.
<b>habitat</b>	A natural home for an animal or plant.
<b>omnivore,</b>	Eats meat and plants.
<b>herbivore</b>	Only eats plants.
<b>carnivore</b>	Only eats meat

<b>village</b>	A small group of houses. Smaller than a town.
