Find out the name of any stories by the authors Janet and Allan Ahlberg. They wrote Funnybones. Can you read any of their other stories? 20 points	Look at videos and photographs of your life. Think about how you have changed and grown. Can you compare this with another animal? 20 points	Think about foods you like. Why do you like them (taste, texture, look) and how does this link to senses? Repeat for foods you don't like. 10 points
Take your favourite toy on an everyday adventure where ordinary objects become extraordinary things. Can you draw a picture of your adventure or even write a story? 40 points	Create a game or senses challenge to play with your family. E.g. blindfolded activities such as obstacles, drawing or tasting. 20 points	Produce a leaflet or poster about an animal including information on its basic parts, babies and what it might eat. 30 points
Can sound travel along a piece of string? Create a cup telephone or similar to test this out. 10 points	Make a poster for yourself to remind you of the things you need to do to keep healthy. 10 points	Make a healthy meal or snack for your family. Think about why it is healthy and how it will help your body. 30 points
