Dear Parents and Carers,

The children have had a fantastic couple of weeks in our new classrooms – they are really making the most of the learning opportunities in our new provision. We're delighted with how the space has turned out, and are very grateful for all your support and encouragement. As you are aware, the building work is ongoing, and this letter is to inform you of the next phase in our exciting development!

Next week, we will be having a canopy installed outdoors. This will allow us to organise the outside space properly, and make sure that our resources are protected from the elements (as well as providing parents with somewhere sheltered to stand at home time!). After the canopy has been installed, the ground can be finished with a layer of tarmac.

This work is due to start next week and is scheduled to take 7 days. This will mean that we need to make a few changes to the arrangements at pick up and drop off times whilst it is ongoing.

Monday 18th November – Tuesday 26th November; all EYFS children will need to be dropped off and picked up at the fire door to the side of the new Nursery classroom.

On Monday 25th November, Nursery parents who collect at 11.45am will need to pick children up from the main school entrance as the tarmac is due to be laid on this day.
