Dear Parents/Carers

On Tuesday 12th November Years 1 and 2 are going on a trip to The National Railway Museum in York. The trip will support our learning about Journeys - which is our topic this term.

The school kitchen will provide all children with a packed lunch unless you indicate on the consent form that you will be providing your own. Please complete and return the attached form by **Friday 25th October**, indicating your child's choice. Please also complete the parental consent on this form.

Your child will need a rucksack/shoulder bag to carry their packed lunch in on the day. Children may also bring a bottle of water to drink throughout the day.

We are planning to visit the museum shop. Children can bring money to spend but we suggest no more than £2.00.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £8.50 per pupil towards the cost of this trip. **We always try to keep costs to a minimum but unfortunately, if there are insufficient contributions, the trip will be cancelled as school funds cannot support the shortfall.** Please contact Mrs Pawley, in confidence, if you would like to arrange a payment plan. Payment is via ParentPay. If you do not have access to the internet or are unable to pay on-line, please contact the school office.

On the day of the visit, the children will need to be at school promptly for 8.50am, to leave by 9.00am. Children will need to be dressed in school uniform and have appropriate footwear and a coat. We will arrive back at school by the end of the school day.

This is a fantastic opportunity for children to reinforce their learning about journeys and transport and we are also hoping to take a trip on a miniature train!
