


<i>light</i>	<i>A form of energy that travels in a straight line.</i>	SCIENCE: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>I recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines.</i> <i>I can use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye.</i> <i>I can explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes.</i> <i>I can use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.</i> 	
<i>travels</i>	<i>To move, typically in a constant and predictable way.</i>		
<i>reflect</i>	<i>To throw back without absorbing it.</i>		
<i>shadows</i>	<i>a dark area or shape produced by an object coming between light and a surface.</i>
