


Reading

Can you follow the words with your finger?




Can you change the ending?




Choose a new book to read.

Remember to help your child to practice writing their name every day. Start with the first letter and practice that until they can do it beautifully! Then move onto the second letter etc.


Phonics




Shapes

Read these instructions to your child and see if they can follow them to add to the drawings on page 8.

1. Colour the star blue.
2. Colour the triangle green.
3. Colour the square red.

7. Draw a face on the sun.

Can you cut out and measure the snakes?




Topic - Geography

Does your child know their address? Practice it with them until they know it off by heart.

Look at the map of Ripon on page 11. Have a look at it with your child; can you find your house? School? Relatives houses? Parks? Etc.

Now look at the map of the British Isles on page 12. Talk to your child about where the sea is. Can you find some of the places you have visited? Maybe you have relatives who live in another part of the country, or have been on a trip somewhere...

Talk to your child about their favourite place. Ask them to draw it on page 13. Talk to them about how it is different to another place; if their favourite place is the seaside, how is that different to Ripon? If their favourite place is the park, how is that different to their house? Etc.
