


	PHSCE	HISTORY: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Germany, Italy (and later Japan) fought against Great Britain, France, Russia (and later the USA) in the Second World War.The Second World War started because Germany invaded Poland.Children were evacuated from cities to the countryside, for example, some children were evacuated from Leeds to Ripon.Rationing was providing of small amounts of certain foods, for example, sugar and chocolate.Rationing was introduced in Britain was introduced in January 1940.
