Record your findings in a tally chart and then put the results on to a bar graph.</p> 
<p>Write 5 facts about the Amazon Rainforest.</p> 	<p>Make a rainstick for the Amazon Rainforest. Follow this link on You Tube for ideas https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=NQgwPSmWLzw</p> 	<p>Use a shoe box to show what it is like in the Amazon Rainforest. How big will your trees be? What animals can you make to put in it?</p> 
<p>Write the names of the 7 continents and 5 oceans of the world.</p> 	<p>Make a list of foods eaten in Brazil. Create your own menu. Can you use your menu to make up some maths questions?</p> 	<p>Choose a tree that is near your house. Observe it carefully every week to see how it changes as it becomes Autumn. Draw a picture every week and put them together into a 'tree diary'.</p>
