Costumes and Cards!

Dear Parents and Carers

As Christmas is finally upon us, we know that the children would like to write Christmas cards for their friends and teachers. It will be slightly different this year as we have to quarantine things coming in from home.

If your child would like to send Christmas cards, they can only do this for children and staff within their bubble. Christmas cards can **only** be brought into school **on Monday 7th December and Monday 14th December. Please do not send cards in on other days of the week as we will be unable to take them.**

We will then quarantine the cards for 72 hours before we give them out for the children to take home. Therefore, Christmas cards will come home on the Thursday 10th December and Thursday 17th December.

The 4 bubbles in our school are:
Bubble 1: Nursery and Reception
Bubble 2: Years 1 and 2
Bubble 3: Years 3 and 4
Bubble 4: Years 5 and 6

We will be filming our Nativity on **Tuesday 8th and Thursday 10th December**. Some children do have PE on those days, but as long as they have trainers with them, they can still do fitness and playground games in their costumes...

On **Tuesday 8th and Thursday 10th December**, please could your child wear the following, depending on the class that they are in:

Nursery and Reception: Grey, black or brown long-sleeved top. Normal grey school skirt/trousers or dark bottoms.

Years 1 and 2: White, cream or grey long-sleeved t shirt/long sleeved top/jumper. White/cream/ grey tights/leggings/joggers.

Years 3 and 4: All black

Years 5 and 6: Black or dark bottoms, a Christmas or sparkly jumper and then some festive headgear or eyewear!
