Reception & Nursery Visit to Monk Park Farm – Thursday 8th July

Reception and Nursery are really looking forward to their trip to Monk Park Farm. This educational visit will give the children first-hand experiences in observing, feeding and handling animals which supports their Knowledge and Understanding of the World.

We are asking for a parental contribution of £13.75 per pupil towards the cost of this visit. We always try to keep costs to a minimum. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough contributions, we may have to cancel the trip. Please contact Mrs Pawley, in confidence, if you would like to arrange a payment plan. Payment is via ParentPay. If you do not have access to the internet or are unable to pay on-line, please contact the school office.

All children need to have a disposable packed lunch. The packed lunch should be in a named carrier/paper bag and should include a boxed fruit drink or water (no fizzy drinks please) and should be easy for your child to eat (no yogurts, sweets or chocolate please). As part of the current Universal Infant Free School Meals, the school kitchen will provide a packed lunch for children who normally have a school dinner. If your child normally has a packed lunch but you would like the school kitchen to provide a packed lunch for this trip, this can be catered for. Please complete and return the attached form by **Friday 25th June** indicating your choices for a school packed lunch or confirming you will be providing your own as well as your parental consent.

For the visit, children will need:

- a waterproof coat
- sensible shoes/trainers
- trousers
- their school sweatshirt/cardigan.

If appropriate, please make sure your child has had sun cream applied and wears a sun hat. **No pocket money is needed.**

We will be leaving school by 9.10am and returning to school by 3.15pm. Please ensure that any child who suffers from travel sickness has taken appropriate medication beforehand and that their class teacher is aware of their medical issues. Any children with asthma **MUST** have their inhaler in school prior to the start of the trip.
