On Wednesday 10th November, Years 1 and 2 are going on a trip to the National Railway Museum in York. The trip will bring our Autumn term theme based on 'Journeys' to life. Your child will need a **rucksack/shoulder bag** to carry their packed lunch on the day and a bottle of water to drink throughout the day.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £12.00 per pupil towards the cost of this trip. **We always try to keep costs to a minimum but unfortunately, if there are insufficient contributions, the trip will be cancelled as school funds cannot support the shortfall.** Please contact Mrs Pawley, in confidence, if you would like to arrange a payment plan. Payment is via ParentPay. If you do not have access to the internet or are unable to pay on-line, please contact the school office.

On the day of the visit, the children will need to be at school promptly for 8.50am, to leave on the bus by 9.00am. The children need to be dressed in school uniform with appropriate footwear and a waterproof coat. We will arrive back at school by the end of the school day.

This is a fantastic opportunity for children to reinforce their learning. First - hand experiences always help to immerse them in our topics.
