<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Nature walk</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Go on a snowy day walk. Can you make footprints? Who has the longest /shortest footprint? Can you toboggan like a penguin or make angels patterns in the snow?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>The Gingerbread man</u></p> <p>Can you make a boat to help the gingerbread man cross the river? What materials could you use? Can you make it float?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Chinese New Year</u></p> <p>Draw a dragon dancing at the Chinese New year festival. Which colours will you need?</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Pancake day</u></p> <p>Design a pancake topping. Ask an adult to make some pancakes. Can you crack the eggs and whisk the mixture? Can you put your favourite topping on?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Freezing and melting</u></p> <p>Freeze some small cups of water or use an ice cube tray. Find different places in and outside to put the ice. Which ice will melt first, second or last? Were your guesses correct?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Penguins</u></p> <p>How many different kinds of penguins are there? Share what you find out with your class in school. Can you make a penguin at home? Here are some ideas to get you started.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spring flowers</u></p> <p>Can you see any spring flowers? Ask someone to help you find out their names. Can you create some spring flower in different ways - perhaps making a collage or using playdough?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Winter</u></p> <p>Trees look very different in winter. Can you draw / print a picture of how the deciduous trees look in winter?</p>  	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Can you build a snowman?</u></p> <p>If we don't have snow. Can you build a snowman model using boxes? Perhaps you could paint a picture or create a chalk drawing outside.</p>
