<p>Build a Tudor house using materials you have at home. Research what Tudor houses looked like to help you.</p> 	<p>Create a persuasive poster to encourage a lady to consider being Henry's new wife. Carefully consider the words and phrases will you include, to make sure your poster is persuasive.</p> 	<p>Write a diary entry as if you are Anne Boleyn on the night before you are about to be beheaded. Include q detailed descriptions of her thoughts and feelings and try to include some rhetorical questions too.</p> 	<p>Write a description of Henry VIII - what type of person was he? Describe his personality as well as his appearance. Is he someone you would have like to have known? Why or why not?</p> 
<p>Create a wedding banquet menu for Henry VIII and one of his wives - remember, they ate a lot of food! Think creatively about how you will present your menu!</p> 	<p>Draw or paint of one of the Tudors you have been learning about, using some of the art skills you have developed in school. We would love some for display in the classroom!</p> 	<p>Use your knowledge of the Tudors (and extra research too) to create a fact file about Henry VIII or one of his wives. I wonder what fun facts can you find to include...?</p> 	<p>Make an A to Z dictionary of words associated with the Tudors. Can you find a word for every letter?</p> 
<p>Design and label an outfit for Henry VIII. Write down the materials you would use and why you have chosen them.</p> 	<p>You have been accused of committing treason, write a letter to Henry VIII begging him not to have you executed. You'll have to be convincing....</p> 	<p>Using Roman Numerals to create a puzzle or game for a partner to complete.</p> 	<p>Research crime and punishment in the Tudor times and create a PowerPoint presentation or a poster to present your findings.</p>
