Dear Parents & Carers

We seem to have many cases of head lice at the moment, especially in Year 4 and Year 2.

Please make sure you treat hair as soon as you find head lice and fine comb hair every night to limit the spread to others. If one egg remains they can re-infect very quickly, so it is important to keep combing regularly. All bed linen and pillows need to be washed also.

Keeping long hair tied back will help to prevent head lice spreading to other children.

Children can return to school but only once they have been treated. If you are struggling to clear headlice in your child's hair, stronger treatment can be prescribed by your GP.
