#### **School Uniform**

All children in Reception to Year 6 need a blue school book bag. They also need their own water bottle if they are in Key Stage 1 or 2. Please ensure that their uniform and all other items are named. Please do not send a pencil case into school with your child - all required stationery is provided.

Our children receive their first hoodie for PE for **free**. These are provided by the Friends of Moorside. Thereafter, they can be purchased from the Ripon Uniform Shop.

We would like to offer you the opportunity to send any (clean and in good condition) uniform (including wellies and trainers) that do not fit your child into school on Wednesday 7th September (delivered to the school office). At the end of the day on Thursday 8th September (3.30pm), you will be able to view the second hand uniform in the hall and can 'buy' items for a donation of your choice. We cannot guarantee that we will have particular sizes or items, but we hope that this is something that you will find useful. Funds raised from uniform donations will go to the Friends of Moorside and therefore provide additional educational experiences and resources for our children.

### **PE and Forest School Days**

On the first day of term, every child should be in school uniform (not PE kit please). We will then send further information about PE and Forest School days for each year group, so that the children are ready each day in the correct kit for their learning activities.

This half term, EYFS and Y1 will have Forest School on a Friday and Y3 and Y4 will have Forest School on a Wednesday, so please ensure that they have wellies and waterproofs ready and named!

#### **Attendance**

Our school day begins at 8.45am for children in Nursery and ends at either 11.45am or 3.15pm for this year group depending on their funding.

School begins at 8.50am for all other year groups.

Reception, Year 1 and 2 finish at 3.15pm and Years 3-6 finish at 3.20pm.

Please make sure that you are on time for school and collection at the end of the day. Lessons and learning tasks begin straight away.

I cannot authorise holiday requests during term-time unless for exceptional circumstances as outlined in the 'Request for Leave of Absence' form. I am more than happy to discuss this in person with you if you feel that you would be eligible. All attendance and term-time holidays are monitored by the Local Authority.

#### **Buddies**

We are currently able to keep our Buddies wrap around care charges the same at £4.50 for breakfast and £3.50 until 4.30pm and £9.00 until 5.30pm (which includes a snack). We must have bookings for wrap around care in advance to ensure that we can provide the correct ratios for staffing. A September booking form has been attached if you need to book any sessions.
