Online Safety - please help!

We have a number of children who are struggling with some of the comments that are made towards them in group chats online outside of school. They will then bring their worries and concerns into school, especially if their peers at Moorside are involved, and we spend time restoring relationships and supporting them with content that has upset them. As parents, it is often difficult to monitor your child's social media activity, but there are some key questions that you can consider to point you in the right direction: Are you aware of what your child is sending/receiving to others? Do you regularly check their phones? What time of night are they messaging each other until? Please see the age restrictions on apps below. None of our children are old enough for any of these apps. As with film restrictions, this is because they are not emotionally mature enough to deal with the content. Please could you help us by monitoring their use if you are allowing them to access these apps. Thank you.
