
Dear Parents and friends,

This week, through art, poetry and music, we have been remembering those who gave their lives during World Wars I and II and learning about why we wear a poppy. The children have asked some fantastic questions and shown great empathy.

Our pupils in Years 5 and 6 enjoyed a 'life in the trenches' experience on Thursday morning and dressed in clothes from the 1940s. In the afternoon, they sang some wartime songs to some of the elderly members of our community. Anti-bullying

Next week is national Anti-Bullying week. In school we will start our week by wearing odd socks <u>on Monday 14th.</u> Wearing odd socks helps us to remember that it's OK to be different! Throughout the rest of the week, we will be completing different activities and having discussions about being kind to everyone (our school rule). Please talk to your child about how important it is to treat everyone with respect, as this will be our key message. Also, keep an eye on our Facebook page for photos and work that we complete during the week.



It is essential - especially now we are heading towards Winter - that all children have a set of waterproofs for Forest School. We have 2 groups per day and if our limited spare waterproofs are worn in the morning, they are often too wet and muddy to be used again that day. Please ensure children have an old coat that can get dirty so that their school coat remains clean and can be used for lunch time and going home in. Our spare kit is for emergencies -we cannot kit out large numbers of children in each session. Children **must** have:

Old clothes on- no white PE t-shirts or hoodies Warm old coat Waterpoof layer- coat and trousers/ suit Spare socks Wellies Extra layers to put on when very cold, including hat and gloves 2 plastic bags for muddy clothes- reusable shopping bags are ideal. Thank you for your support.
