Reading Raffle Week 2

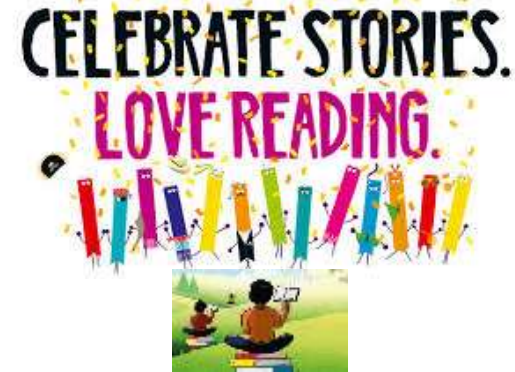
Complete a 7 day reading bingo challenge to enter into the Reading Raffle for the opportunity to win a prize!

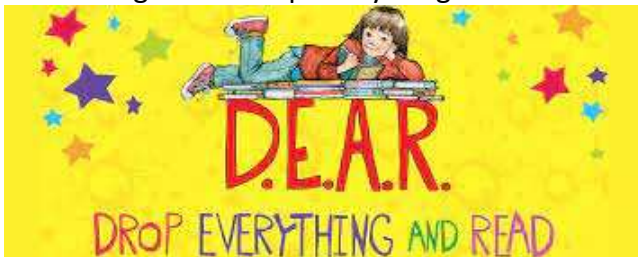
On Wednesday 1st March 2023, Moorside Primary School and Nursery is launching its 10th annual Reading Extravaganza!

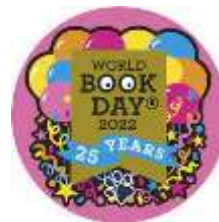


World Book Day!
