


Dear Parents and friends,

Maths at Moorside



Month of Reading Madness

The month of March is our annual Month of Reading Madness! This is launched on 1st March with lots of reading activities to take part in both at home and at school! Our flyer full of information is attached and we will send a paper copy home for you too! The children love the 'drop everything and read' activity in school and we can't wait to receive 'I spy you reading photos' and obviously the fun of getting dressed up for World Book Day on Thursday 2nd March. We will be having our themed 'Mad Hatter's Lunch' on World Book Day too - please have a look at the menu at the end of this letter for more details and email admin to book a lunch for your child if they usually have a packed lunch!

At Moorside, our curriculum is based on learning through stories and carefully selected texts, to support children's vocabulary development, and enable us to deliver our Literacy lessons through a 'talk for writing approach'. You might want to read these books together with your children to help them with their fluency and provide an opportunity for them to retell the story!

Nursery have begun the half term with 'Jack and the Beanstalk' (with lots of learning about measuring taller/short/longer) whilst Reception have been reading 'Mr Wolf's Pancakes' (super link to pancake day!). In Year 1, the children have been reading the poetry book, 'The Wind Blew', and Year 2 have just started 'The Magic Faraway Tree' by Enid Blyton. Year 3 are learning about Ancient Egypt, and are reading 'The Egyptian Cinderella' whilst Year 4 continue with Charlie and the Chocolate Factory and Years 5 and 6 are reading 'The Boy with the Bronze Axe'!



Holi Charity Fund-raising Run



Our School Council have organised a colour run for Holi, the Hindu festival of colours, which is being celebrated on 8th March this year. The children will be running approximately one mile, whilst being showered with paint and (a bit of) water for a fantastic cause. 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Uniform

Please note that children should be in school uniform on days when they do not have PE or Forest School. Our Uniform Policy is on our website. Make-up and coloured hair are prohibited in school and children should not wear jewellery. They can wear stud earrings - unless they are doing PE. We also request that girls' skirts (A-line or pleated) are at least knee length. If they are shorter, we request that they wear a pair of shorts underneath; girls are also allowed to wear trousers if they prefer. Mini-skirts are not acceptable. Thank you for your support with this matter.
