Dear Parents/Carers

On Tuesday 27th June, Years 1 and 2 are going on a trip to Saltburn-by-the-Sea. The trip will bring our learning about Inventions during the Victorian period (which we are learning about in history) to life, as well as looking at physical features of beaches, cliffs and coasts which we are learning about in Geography. There is a Victorian pier and tramway and a mini museum to explain how it was built in 1884!

The school kitchen will provide all children with a packed lunch unless you indicate on the consent form that you will be providing your own. Please complete and return the attached form by **Friday 12th May 2023**, indicating your child's choice. Please also complete the parental consent on this form.

Your child will need a **rucksack/shoulder bag** to carry their packed lunch on the day and a bottle of water to drink throughout the day. The children can also bring a bucket and spade (in a named carrier bag) as we will hopefully have time to play on the beach if the weather is kind to us! We also strongly recommend that they wear a sun hat and bring sun cream (named) in their bags.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £11.50 per pupil towards the cost of this trip. **We always try to keep costs to a minimum but unfortunately, if there are insufficient contributions, the trip will be cancelled as school funds cannot support the shortfall.** Please contact Mrs Pawley, in confidence, if you would like to arrange a payment plan. Payment is via ParentPay. If you do not have access to the internet or are unable to pay on-line, please contact the school office.

On the day of the visit, the children will need to be at school promptly for 8.45am, to leave on the bus by 9.00am. The children do not need to be dressed in school uniform but must be dressed appropriately for a day outside at the beach, with appropriate footwear and a waterproof coat. We will arrive back at school by the end of the school day (we will inform you of any traffic issues if necessary).

This is a fantastic opportunity for children to reinforce their learning about the Victorian era as well as investigating physical features in Geography. First - hand experiences always help to bring their learning to life!
