Vapes




There has been a lot of media coverage about vaping recently! This is an extremely concerning issue locally and nationally. It has been reported to us that there are adults in Ripon who are unfortunately selling vapes to primary-age children, who are unaware of the long-term impact of the chemicals that they are sucking into their lungs which are still developing. There may be vapes left in local parks and community areas which are colourful and potentially appealing to some children to try. Please talk to your children about the age restriction for vaping being 18 and warn them

not to try anything given to them by any children or adults as it is not safe.
