Mobile phones

We continue to support individuals and groups of pupils with appropriate use of mobile phones outside of school. School involvement has been necessary to restore friendships and educate children about keeping themselves safe, when they have been accessing inappropriate material. We will <u>not</u> be allowing children to bring mobile phones to school from September.



We understand that parents can feel under pressure to let their children either use their phones or buy them their own, but if this is the case, they do need careful monitoring! There are some helpful tips at https://saferinternet.org.uk/guide-and-resource/parents-and-carers/phones with details about some of the ways that you can support your child to keep them safe online. Please also remember that apps have age restrictions for a reason! Children cannot see who they are communicating with in chat groups and do not always have restrictions on their phones to protect them. Online safety is paramount to supporting

your child's mental health so please check your child's phone as frequently as you can!

PHSCE Visit

We were really grateful to PCSO Phil, who came in to speak to our children in Upper Key Stage 2 about Cyber Safety and the dangers of Vaping this afternoon. Both issues are topical and relevant to visit regularly, to give opportunities to talk in a safe environment. The children asked some good questions. Please talk openly with your child about it and encourage them to put any worries in the Worry Box at school if they would like to talk to an adult or raise any concerns.



Class Organisation 2023-24

We were delighted to begin our transition activities this week with some of our Year 6's visiting new Secondary Schools and some of our teachers have been visiting children who they will be teaching next year in their current Nursery provisions and classrooms. We also loved meeting with our new starter parents for Reception on Thursday afternoon. We will be having a transition morning for our current children to spend time with their class teachers for 2023-24 on Wednesday 12th July and we will send home letters to inform you of staffing arrangements on that day. We have taken our time to finalise our plans, as we are still receiving admissions requests for September from new families moving into the area! We look forward to welcoming them to Team Moorside!

One of our events to celebrate the end of primary school for Year 6 is the Leavers' Service at Ripon Cathedral on 7th July. The children will leave school at 9.45am and return before lunch. If the weather forecast is poor, they may need a rain coat on that day. Children must be in full school uniform. They can wear their Leavers' hoodie or a school jumper.

School Meals



Unfortunately, we have been informed that the price of our school meals will be increasing again in September to £3.15 per meal, per day. This price is set by North Yorkshire County Caterers and is out of our control but is due mainly to the continuing rise in wholesale food costs. Children from Reception to Year 2 will continue to benefit from the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM), but if you think your child in Years 3-6 may be eligible for benefits-related free school meals, please ask for a form from the school office or you can apply using the link below:
