Dear Parents,

On the morning of Thursday 16th November, Year 6 will be visiting the 'Crucial Crew' event at Carlton Lodge Activity Centre, Carlton Miniott, Thirsk. The event is designed to educate Year 6 pupils in North Yorkshire, to make informed decisions and respond effectively to emergency situations and accidents.

The event will feature a series of 10-minute workshops, designed to promote an awareness of crime and crime prevention issues, relevant to the students' communities. Workshops will include the following:

- **Road Safety** – Helping students to understand why we need safe roads for all (Road Safety Week 19 – 25 Nov), delivered by North Yorkshire Police.
- **Sexting** – Understanding the Crime & Consequences of Sharing nudes, delivered by North Yorkshire Police.
- **Fire Safety** – Keeping safe and making 999 calls, delivered by North Yorkshire Fire & Rescue.
- **Water Safety** – Keeping safe in and around water, delivered by North Yorkshire Youth.
- **Alcohol – ASB** – Understanding the Crime & Consequences, delivered by North Yorkshire Police.
- **Drugs** – Keeping safe and identifying dangers, delivered by North Yorkshire Youth.

The event encourages active participation, and is relevant to the school's citizenship curriculum. We encourage all Year 6 children to attend.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £9.50 for the workshops and coach travel which is payable via ParentPay.
