












Year 1 and 2 Homework Challenge - Explorers

Do you know which plant, tree or hedge they are from?</p> 	<p>Write the names of the countries and capital cities of the UK.</p> 
<p>Design a healthy meal. You can use a paper plate or cut out around a plate on some card. Think about vegetables/fruit, proteins, dairy and not too many carbohydrates or fats.</p> 	<p>Write 5 facts about penguins.</p> 	<p>Make a toilet roll penguin.</p> 
<p>Draw animals and name their young.</p> 	<p>If you were going to explore, what would you pack in your bag? Draw and Label your contents.</p> 	<p>Find out about some of the clothes and equipment that Captain Scott took with him when he explored Antarctica.</p>
