



<b>deciduous</b>	Trees which lose their leaves in winter	<b>SCIENCE: Plants</b> Trees which lose their leaves are called deciduous and trees which don't lose their leaves are called evergreen. Plants have roots, stems, leaves In springtime buds appear and new plants begin to grow I can name at least 4 different flowers I can name at least 4 different trees	<b>SCIENCE: Seasonal Changes</b> There are 4 seasons Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter in a Year. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Day and night length changes because of the earth tilting us closer or further away from the sun.</li> <li>• Colder weather comes in autumn and winter. Warmer weather comes in spring and summer.</li> <li>• The weather and light affect what happens to deciduous trees and plants.</li> </ul>	
<b>evergreen</b>	A plant that retains green leaves throughout the year			
<b>root</b>	Part of a plant which attaches to the ground			
<b>stem</b>	The main body or stalk of a plant			
<b>leaves</b>	A flattened structure that is attached to a stem			
<b>bud</b>	A growth on a plant that develops into a leaf, flower or shoot
