

Year 6's ADVENTURE to the BIG City!

Dear Parents,

As we are sadly nearing the end of the children's time at Moorside, we have planned a final memorable trip for them to embark on, before leaving us to begin their new adventures at Secondary school.

To broaden their learning experiences and independence, we would like to take them on a day trip to...

LONDON!

The visit will take place on Wednesday 3rd July 2024. The itinerary will be as follows:

07.15 Meet at Harrogate train station (subject to change).

07.37 (approx) Depart Harrogate direct to London Kings Cross.

10.31 Arrive at London Kings Cross and take underground to Victoria/Westminster.

11.00 – Thames River Tour to the Tower of London.

See the London Landmarks: The London Eye, The Shard, Big Ben, Westminster, The Tower of London etc. with a guided tour.

12.20 -Lunch at Prezzo's – Victoria Station.

14.00 Arrive at the Apollo Theatre to watch 'WICKED'.

14.30 Show begins.

17.00 Show ends.

17.30 Walk to Buckingham Palace – picnic here (packed tea) OR on way home.

19.00 Arrive Kings Cross and visit Platform 9 ¾ (for the Harry Potter fans).

20.00 (approx) Train home.

22.44 Arrive Harrogate for collection by parents.

We will be able to confirm exact train times 12 weeks in advance of the trip.

We anticipate that the total cost of the trip (which can be paid in instalments) will be approximately £105.00, based on current prices (we can confirm the exact amount when train tickets have been purchased). This will cover their return train journey, breakfast on the train, theatre ticket, boat tour, lunch at Prezzo's and refreshments throughout the day.

There will be a ratio of 1 adult to 5 children and we have carried out risk assessments in line with North Yorkshire policies. We will be carrying out a pre-trip visit to ensure that all routes that we take are safe. We will also send you text updates as much as we can throughout the day.
