












## Year 1 and 2 Homework Challenge - Influential People

<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Ripon Hornblower</u></b></p> <p>Can you draw and label a picture of the horn which is used in the market square each night? You might need to look on the Internet to find a photo to help you.</p> <p>If you don't want to draw a picture, maybe you could make one. What materials could you use?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Introducing a place in Ripon</u></b></p> <p>Choose a tourist attraction in Ripon, such as the Workhouse Museum or Cathedral. Design a poster to advertise it. Why should people visit? What are the important features? Can you draw a map to get to it from the Market Square?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Go on a detective walk</u></b></p> <p>Go on a walk in your local area. Take a photograph of any building that you think looks old (you might want to ask an adult to help you out here). Look at the photographs you have taken. Why do you think they are old? Could you put the photographs in order from the oldest to the newest?</p>

What things can you find made from wood, plastic, glass, water, rock? How will you record what you have found? You could make a table or a bar chart, take photos or drawings. You could include: sketching, collage (using a range of materials), pastels or paint.
