


identify	To work out what something is	<p>SCIENCE: Materials</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *All objects are made of one or more materials. *The same object can be made from different materials eg a chair can be made from wood, plastic or metal *I can identify if an object is made from wood, plastic, glass, metal and rock. *I know the properties of 4 different materials. *The properties of some materials are not always the same eg wood can be rough or smooth. 	<p>SCIENCE: Seasonal Changes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> . There are 4 seasons Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter in a Year. • Day and night length changes because of the earth tilting us closer or further away from the sun. • Colder weather comes in autumn and winter. Warmer weather comes in spring and summer. • The weather and light affect what happens to deciduous trees and plants.
