



GEOGRAPHY - NORWAY		IMPORTANT KNOWLEDGE (Five Finger Facts)	  
Country	Land that is controlled by a single government.	Norway is a Scandinavian country in the northern hemisphere, in the continent of Europe.	
Fjords	A long, narrow, deep inlet of the sea between high cliffs.	The climate in Norway differs depending on its location (inland and coastal)	
Erosion	When natural forces like wind, water, or ice wear away and move bits of rock, soil, and sand from one place to another.	Norway is a mountainous country with fjords between them, which were formed when glaciers eroded deep into U-shaped valleys.	
Export	Sending goods or services from one country to another for sale	Norway is a major trading nation, known for exporting petroleum, natural gas, and fish, and importing machinery and food products.	
Continent	A very large area of land on Earth, like a giant puzzle piece, where many countries and people live	The country's climate, influenced by the North Atlantic Ocean, creates a unique environment that supports a mix of Arctic and temperate species.

Light	A type of energy that allows us to see	I know that I need light in order to see things.	
Source	Where something comes from or begins, or the cause of something	I know that dark is the absence of light.	
Shadow	A dark area or shape created when something blocks light.	I know that light is reflected from surfaces.	
Reflection	The way light bounces off a surface like a mirror.	I know that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways I can protect my eyes.	
Darkness	Dark means that light is absent	I know that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.	
RE - Diwali		IMPORTANT KNOWLEDGE (Five Finger Facts)	
Diwali	A special Hindu festival that celebrates light, good winning over evil, and the story of Rama and Sita.	Diwali celebrates the story of Rama and Sita where good conquers evil.	
Goddess	A female god. In Diwali, Hindus welcome the goddess Lakshmi, who brings good luck.	To prepare for Diwali, Hindus make sure their house is very clean, they do all the laundry and buy new clothes and jewels for everyone in the house.	
Rangoli	Bright and colourful patterns made on the floor to decorate homes and bring good luck.	Hindus send cards to friends and family sharing their thoughts and good wishes.	
Diyas	Small oil lamps made of clay that are lit during Diwali to show light beating darkness.	Rangoli patterns are created on the floor to welcome the goddess Lakshmi and to ward off evil spirits.	
Celebrate	To do something special, like a party or tradition, to remember an important time or event.	Hindus put Diyas on their windowsills during Diwali to remind them of the power of good over evil.
