#### **Reading Plus and Reading Eggs**



We recommend that children use Reading Plus at home at least 3 times per week! All passwords for Reading Plus and Reading Eggs are in children's reading records. We have a Reading Plus information evening on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> November so that you can support your child with this at home. All parents of children in Years 3-6 are very welcome. On arrival every adult will receive a free raffle ticket for the chance to win a Reading raffle prize! We hope to see as many of you there as possible.

#### School collection

Please could you give us as much warning as possible if an alternative adult is collecting your child at the end of the school day?

This is so that we can ensure that we can get messages down to classrooms in time for pick-ups, and to avoid people having to wait for us to ensure that everyone is going home with the correct adult. We hope you understand that this is to keep everyone safe. As the evenings get darker, please ensure that you are close enough to the exit doors so that staff can see you - it is difficult under hoods and umbrellas when the light is getting dimmer! Thank you!

#### **Attendance**

Our attendance will be monitored by the Local Authority at the end of term - children whose attendance is below 92% will be highlighted to us to provide additional information about any authorised and unauthorised absences. We always try our best to support families who are struggling to get children into school on time and will continue to do so to avoid any action and fining by the Local Authority. If your child's attendance is a concern and you need any support, please contact Mrs Price who is our first point of call to help with this. We will continue to celebrate good attendance
