


SCIENCE		<p>IMPORTANT KNOWLEDGE</p> <p>SCIENCE: Living things and where there live</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The world is made of things that are living and non living. A living thing is something that needs food, water and air. All living things have the same life processes. A non-living thing is something that has never been alive. A habitat is where plants or animals live depending on their basic needs. 	 
habitat	The place where a plant or animal lives is called its habitat.		
living	Something that is living is alive. It can grow, reproduce, move, feed and get rid of waste material.		
plant	A plant is a living thing that often has roots, stem and leaves.		
minibeast	You can call very small creatures, such as insects or spiders, minibeasts.		
microhabitat	A microhabitat is a very small habitat. It might be just under one tree or log, or a single rock pool.

RE		<p>RE: Why is the Torah special?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Jewish place of worship is called a synagogue where rabbis read from a holy book called a Torah. Moses is an important man for Jews because he first wrote down the Torah. There are 10 commandments which are rules that God wanted Jews to obey given to Moses on Mount Sinai. The Torah teaches Jews about God and how He wants people to behave. The Torah includes stories and 613 rules to help Jews live a good life. 	
Synagogue	The special place where Jewish people go to worship and pray.		
Rabbi	A Jewish teacher who helps people learn from the Torah.		
commandments	Rules God gave to help people live the right way.		
Mount Sinai	The mountain where Moses received the ten commandments from God.		
Moses	An important leader who helped Jewish people and talked to God.
