Pollination	How flowers make seeds so they can grow into new plants.	SCIENCE: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plants reproduce to make new plants or offspring in different ways. Plants can reproduce asexually which means a single parent plant can reproduce on its own. Cutting produces clones of parent plants that are identical. Flowering plants reproduce by making seeds which grow into new plants. Pollination is the transfer of the pollen from one flower to the stigma of another flower. 	
Germination	The process of a seed waking up and starting to grow into a new plant.		
Asexual	A way for a plant to make new baby plants (offspring) all by itself, without needing another plant to help.		
Stigma	The stigma is the very top part of the female centre of a flower.		
Anther	An anther is the part of a flower that makes and holds pollen.

Olympics	The world's biggest sports party, where over 200 different countries come together to compete.	HISTORY: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hippocrates influenced our society's knowledge of illness and medicine. Archimedes was an inventor who has influenced our knowledge of maths and science. 1500 years after the Ancient Greeks introduced the Olympic Games, they are now used as a celebration of sport around the world. The Ancient Greeks built grand buildings with distinctive features such as columns, friezes and ceremonial gateways which are still seen in buildings today. Democracy, which began in Ancient Greece, is part of our British culture today. 	
Democracy	Where everyone has a voice and helps make decisions, usually by voting for leaders or choices		
Frieze	A decorative band, usually, but not always, above a doorframe or on the wall near the ceiling.		
Parthenon	An ancient, white marble temple built over 2,400 years ago on a hilltop in Athens, to honour Athena.		
Corinthian Column	A fancy, decorative style of pillar from Ancient Greece.		
RE - WHERE DID THE CHRISTIAN BIBLE COME FROM?		IMPORTANT KNOWLEDGE (Five Finger Facts)	
Scholars	Experts who study and interpret historical texts like the Bible.	RE: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The first five books of the Old Testament originate from the five books of Moses found in the Jewish Torah. Most scholars agree the Old Testament was written between 800 BC and 200 BC, although there is writing as far back as 2000 BC. The oldest parts of the Bible were not written down on paper. They were passed on from generation to generation through stories. This is known as an oral tradition. Until around the 15th century, most Bibles were written in Latin meaning only people with an education could understand them. Some Christians believe that the Bible is literally true whereas others believe it is a symbolic truth. 	
Generation	A group of people born around the same time who pass stories and traditions on.		
Oral Tradition	Stories and teachings passed down by word of mouth before being written down.		
Literal	Believing something is exactly true as it is written.		
Symbolic	Understanding something as representing a deeper meaning rather than being literally true.
