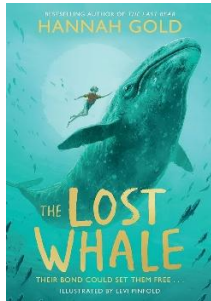


Art & Climate Awareness

Create a poster inspired by *The Lost Whale* by Hannah Gold that raises awareness about the impact of climate change on oceans and wildlife.



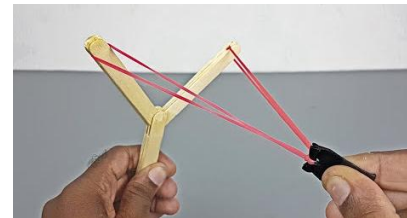
Writing & Reflection

Write a diary entry as if you were a young explorer or diver discovering the effects of climate change on the ocean. Include your feelings, observations and ideas for helping the environment.



Science & Forces

Build a simple machine at home using items like cardboard, rubber bands or straws. Your machine could lift, pull or move an object in a clever way. Show how it works, describe which forces are at play.



Geography & Fairtrade

Research a Fairtrade product you enjoy (like chocolate, bananas or tea). Create a poster explaining where it comes from, how it helps people and why Fairtrade is important for sustainability.



Making & Creativity

Construct a model of a renewable energy device (like a wind turbine, water wheel, or solar panel) using household materials. Explain how it works.



Design & Sustainability

Design and make an eco-friendly product for everyday life. Think about materials, energy use, and how it helps the planet. Draw it, label it, and explain how it reduces waste or saves energy.



Writing & Persuasion

Write a short speech persuading others to act on climate change or protecting the environment. Imagine you are a young climate activist like Greta Thunberg. Include your ideas, feelings and why it's important for everyone to help.
