SCIENCE - Keeping healthy		IMPORTANT KNOWLEDGE (Five Finger Facts)	
Diet	Types and range of food and drink that a person consumes regularly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eating a balanced diet helps your body grow, stay healthy, and lowers the risk of diseases. Exercise makes your heartbeat faster, helping move oxygen around your body and making your heart stronger. Drugs change how the body works: some are safe if given by doctors, but illegal drugs are harmful and unsafe. Nicotine in tobacco is addictive; smoking harms the body and can cause disease, and vaping is less harmful but still not safe. Alcohol is an addictive drug that affects thinking and can damage the body, increasing the risk of serious illnesses. 	
Nutrients	Essential substances found in food and drink that the body needs to live, grow, and stay healthy.		
Addictive	Something that makes you feel a very strong urge to keep doing it or using it, even if you know it is not good for you.		
Exercise	Any planned, structured physical activity that makes the body work harder than usual to improve or maintain health, fitness and overall well-being.

Fossil fuels	Natural energy sources formed from the remains of ancient plants and animals that died millions of years ago.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oil, coal and gas are fossil fuels that, once used, cannot be replaced. Wind, sun and water are natural sources of energy (renewable) that will never run out. Climate change is caused by greenhouse gases (CO2 and methane) which surround Earth like a blanket warming it up. Climate change affects changing weather, rising sea levels, water, food and animals. The UK currently imports and exports over 50% of goods to countries within Europe. 	
Renewable	Energy that comes from natural sources that will never run out, or that can be replaced (replenished) naturally within a short time		
Imports	Goods or services that are brought IN to one country from another country		
Exports	Goods or services produced in one country and sold to customers, businesses or governments in another country		
RE - What is a Church?			IMPORTANT KNOWLEDGE (Five Finger Facts)
A church	A building where people congregate and worship, but it is also a community of people who share the same religious beliefs.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Christianity is a religion which began after Jesus died. His disciples and apostles had no money to build churches at first. Heavily populated areas have megachurches, where thousands of people can worship together. Beautiful decorations inside a church help people feel like they are in a special, important place and reminds them of Bible stories and teachings. In very poor areas or hot climates, churches may congregate outside rather than in a building. Different denominations of Christianity have different traditions, ceremonies and clothing. 	
Disciples	The followers of Jesus who learned from him and spread his teachings.		
Apostles	Early Christian leaders who helped spread Christianity after Jesus' death.		
Denominations	Different groups or branches within Christianity with their own traditions.		
Congregate	To come together as a group, especially for worship or meetings.
