Dear Reception Parents/Carers

Reception & Nursery Visit to Thorp Perrow – Tuesday 23rd June

Reception and Nursery are really looking forward to their trip to Thorp Perrow. This educational visit will support the children's learning of the EYFS curriculum area 'Understanding the World'. During the visit, they will have first-hand experience in observing animals, finding out about where they live and what they eat. We will also be exploring different habitats and identifying the animals that live there.

All Nursery children are invited to attend the trip, even if Thursday is not their usual day to attend or if they normally finish at lunch time!

All children will require a packed lunch. Please complete and return the attached form by Friday 5th June indicating your choices or confirming that you will be providing your own. If you wish your child to bring in a packed lunch from home, please ensure that it is disposable and that it includes a boxed fruit drink or water (no fizzy drinks), it is easy for your child to eat (no sweets or chocolate) and be nut free. Please also complete the parental consent on this form.

We are asking for a contribution of £14 per pupil towards the cost of this trip. We always try to keep costs to a minimum but unfortunately, if we do not receive enough contributions, then we may have to cancel the trip. Payment is via ParentPay. If you do not have access to the internet or are unable to pay on-line, please contact the school office.

On the day of the visit, the children will need to be at school for 8.45am, to leave promptly at 9.00am. We will arrive back by 3.15pm.

For the visit, children will need:

- a waterproof coat
- sensible shoes/trainers
- trousers
- their school sweatshirt/cardigan
- a rucksack to carry their lunch, drink and coat

If appropriate, please make sure your child has had sun cream applied and wears a sun hat.

Please ensure that any child who suffers from travel sickness has taken appropriate medication beforehand and that their class teacher is aware of their medical issues. Any children with asthma MUST have their inhaler in school prior to the start of the trip.
