Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 5 Trip to Yorkshire Sculpture Park

Year 5 are really excited about their upcoming trip to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park! This will be a fantastic opportunity for the children to explore and enjoy a wide range of amazing sculptures set in beautiful outdoor surroundings. The visit will support their Art learning in the summer term, where they will be creating their own sculptures and developing their ideas about shape, materials and design.

The trip also links to our Geography topic about trading, climate and sustainability. While at the park, the children will have the chance to explore how the environment is cared for, how the land is used and how art can work alongside nature in a sustainable way. This will help them understand how people can look after the world around them.

We will visit the park on **Tuesday 19th May**. We will travel by coach, leaving school at 9.00am and returning by 3.20pm.

All children will need a disposable packed lunch. The packed lunch should be in a named carrier/paper bag and should include a boxed fruit drink or water (no fizzy drinks please). The school kitchen can provide a packed lunch if required. Please complete and return the attached form by Friday 1st May indicating your choice or confirming you will provide your own.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £13.50 per pupil towards the cost of this trip. We always try to keep costs to a minimum but unfortunately, if there are insufficient contributions, the trip will be cancelled as school funds cannot support the shortfall. Please contact Mrs Pawley, in confidence, if you would like to arrange a payment plan. Payment is via ParentPay. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office.

Parental consent is also required to confirm that you are happy for your child to attend this trip.

For the visit, children will need:

- to wear comfy casual clothes
- their Moorside PE hoodies
- a waterproof coat (just in case)
- sensible footwear
- a sunhat if the weather is warm
- a named water bottle
- a packed lunch

As we will be spending most of the day outdoors, please ensure your child brings suitable items for the weather on the day. We will send further information closer to the date once we have a clearer weather forecast.
