arteries	Blood vessels that carry blood away from the heart to the rest of the body.		
organ	A part of the body (like the heart or lungs) that does a special job to keep you alive.		
oxygenated	Blood that has lots of oxygen in it (usually after passing through the lungs).		
deoxygenated	Blood that has little oxygen left because the body has used it up.		
veins	Blood vessels that carry blood back to the heart from the body.		
GEOGRAPHY- Trading, Climate and Sustainability		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oil, coal and gas are fossil fuels that, once used, cannot be replaced. Wind, sun and water are natural sources of energy (renewable) that will never run out. Climate change is caused by greenhouse gases (CO2 and methane) which surround Earth like a blanket warming it up. Climate change affects changing weather, rising sea levels, water, food and animals. fossil fuels	Fuels like coal, oil and gas that were made from ancient plants and animals over millions of years.		
renewable,	Energy that can be used again and again and won't run out (like wind or solar power).		
imports and exports	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Imports - Goods brought into a country from another country Exports - Goods sent out of a country to another country 		
energy sources	Different ways we get power to heat, light, and run things (like electricity from the sun, wind, or fuels).		
climate	The usual weather in a place over a long period of time (for example, hot, cold, wet, or dry).

worship	showing respect and love for God, often through prayer, music or art.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> People express their religious beliefs through the arts for many reasons. In lots of religions, part of the scriptures or religious writings are turned into songs. Members of the clergy wear clothes called vestments. Throughout the year, the colours they wear will often change depending on what festival is being celebrated or the time of year. Some religious people believe that paintings showing religious figures and stories are sacred because they are a reflection of what is written in scriptures. Islamic art focuses on calligraphy and arabesque patterns. It uses a lot of leaf and flower imagery to reflect creation. 	
scriptures	holy writings or religious texts considered sacred.		
clergy	religious leaders like priests or ministers who lead worship and ceremonies.		
vestments	special clothes worn by members of the clergy during religious services.		
calligraphy	artistic handwriting or lettering, often used in Islamic art.
