Dear Parents and children!

Welcome back to the new school year....2026-2027!

We are really excited to see everyone in the morning and welcome the children into their new learning environments, which are looking super! Just a few reminders and information to help with the start of the new term and the first morning back!

Entrances for Children in the Morning

The children in Years 1 and 2 will need to gather on the playground opposite the Lead Lane gate in the morning and the Key Stage 1 staff will come out to line them up at 8.50am so that they can then enter through the door next to their cloakrooms. Please collect children from this entrance at the end of the day.

The children in Reception will enter through their door which is to the right of the Key Stage 1 door (in the courtyard where there is a snake on the ground) – again, if you are unsure, please gather on the playground opposite the Lead Lane gate and an adult will direct you.

For Key Stage 2, you can stand on the other playground opposite our main School Office or on the same playground as Key Stage 1 if you have children in both parts of school – the classroom doors for KS2 in order from the Key Stage 2 playground are; Year 3, Year 6, Year 4 and Year 5.

Children in Reception and Years 1-5 must have an adult with them either until they are lined up or have walked into the school building for supervision and safety. If you have a child in Year 6, they can walk to school themselves if you wish but you will need to send an email to confirm that they can be released to walk home on their own at the end of the school day.

Reception Settling in Hours this Week

It is a particularly exciting week for our children in Reception who begin their educational journey at Primary school with us this week. So that we can support them in their transition, their hours in school this week are:

Please send all children to school in their usual uniform on Tuesday 8th September.
